Entry Fees

\$27 for 1st entry of each dog and \$22 for each additional entry of same dog in same trial. The a.m. and p.m. Rally trials are separate events. Brace: \$27 per team. Fees include: \$3 AKC Event Service Fee and \$.50 recording fee on the 1st entry of a dog and \$3.50 AKC Event Service Fee for each add'l entry of same dog in regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, or \$3.50 AKC Event Service Fee on each entry of a dog in Rally.

Do not send cash. **NOTE:** Only payment by PayPal includes an upcharge of \$2 over and above the fee for each entry. Canadian exhibitors: make fees payable in U.S. funds. Exhibitors will be charged \$35 for returned checks and their entries invalidated.

Receipt of entries will be acknowledged by email. There will be a drop-box available at the Club site.

Closing Date

Entries must be received on or before 6:00 p.m. (EST) on April 3, 2024 or when the limits are reached, after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, or substituted. Facsimiles are not acceptable. The drop-box will be removed April 1, 2024 at 5:00 p.m.

Notice to Exhibitors

Refunds: If a bitch comes in season after the Closing Date, the entry fee, less \$10, will be refunded if a statement from the exhibitor is presented to the Trial Secretary by 9 am on the trial date. Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by a judge or veterinarian, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. Entry fees will not be refunded if it is impossible to open or complete the trial due to riots, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of OTCGL. Owners are responsible for errors in completing entry forms. Entry fees will not be refunded for errors or cancellations after the Closing Date.

Anyone requiring special accommodations or with special requirements should contact the Trial Chair prior to the trial.

The building will NOT be available the night before the trial. On trial days, dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled judging time. Dogs not required for further judging are excused. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called. Dogs must be on leash or in crates except when being judged. No practicing allowed in the rings at any time.

OTCGL assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or their dogs or property. OTCGL does not agree to arbitrate claims set forth on the official AKC Entry Form for these events.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to ensure their dogs are free from parasites, communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
